Subject: Annex to the October 2006 convoy distribution report

Dear Mr. Newitt,

In (January 2007, Genesis Project team was ready to continue distribution of computers brought by B.A.R.F., part of October 2006 convoy. During the previous report, we informed you about the distribution of 14 computers in different locations. Since B.A.R.F. brought us a total of 40 computers in the October convoy, this meant that we still had to check and distribute the remaining 26 computers.

Deliberately we waited couple of months (period between October 2006 – January 2007) in order to be able to distribute computers to selected primary schools in Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina (another Bosnia and Herzegovina entity) as well as to some primary schools in Republika Srpska.

During January and February 2007, we have made the computer distributions as below:-

* Equipment donated to the Secondary electro-technical school "Nikola Tesla" in Banjaluka was damaged and we could not repair it, so since it could not be used in primary schools we donated it to this Secondary school for the classes of school practice (for school pupils to teach how to repair computers and other equipment).

We have now finalised the distribution of all aid brought as part of October 2006 convoy. We are fully ready to welcome new convoy (February 2007) and to organize distribution of all humanitarian aid that B.A.R.F. will bring this time.
